Dr. Lisa Arbisser Brothers, daughter of Dr. Joyce Brothers, will speak about the incredible path of her mother's career which broke the glass ceiling in the field of psychology. Dr. Arbisser is a recognized leader in cataract and anterior segment surgery. She co-founded Eye Surgeons Associates, PC., an eight office/22 doctor/180 employee integrated lowa and Illinois practice. Graduating with honors from Princeton University, she received her MD (AOA) from the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston and NIH fellowship in neurobiology and retina before

completing ophthalmology residency and associate fellowship in anterior segment surgery at the University of Iowa. She's an adjunct professor at the University of Utah Moran Eye Center, a frequent visiting professor and invited speaker, an author of textbook chapters, and former editor of Focal Points. She privately coaches surgeons since retiring from direct patient care after 30 years in practice. Her numerous awards include two AAO Secretariat awards and two ASCRS peer-voted Golden Apple Awards for surgical teaching. She has performed satellite surgery in the US and abroad. She served on the AAO online news and education network (ONE) for over a decade in addition to countless editorial boards and is a former president of the American College of Eye Surgeons and served as education director on the board of Women in Ophthalmology. She was voted among the top 50 opinion leaders by Cataract and Refractive Surgery Today and was one of the earliest female KOL's for industry in cataract surgery. The American Women's Medical Association recognized her as an Iowa Living Legend, and she's been honored as a lifetime member of the lowa Volunteer Hall of Fame. She is a third generation professional woman, wife and mother of 4 and grandmother of 5. She is a co-founder and co-owner of Minute Suites, private rooms to rent inside security at US airports.
