

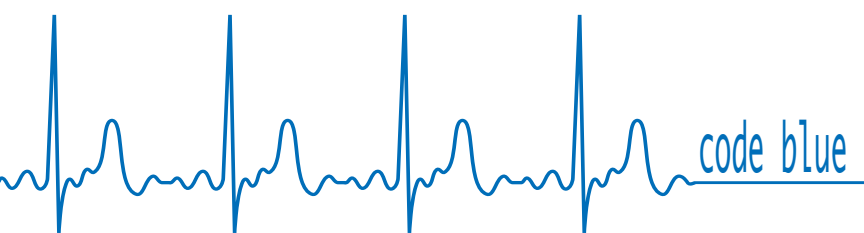

The choices we make in the legislature today will affect the long-term health of the healthcare delivery system in Connecticut.

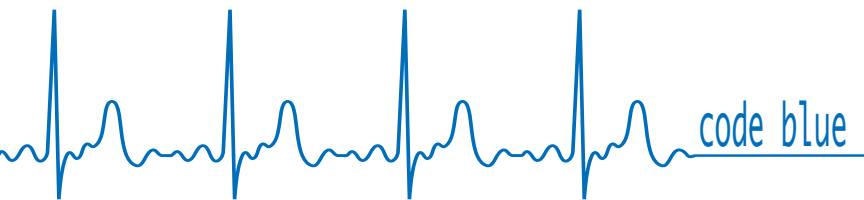

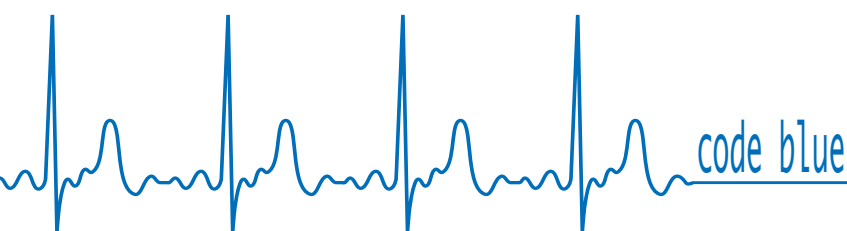

Please Support

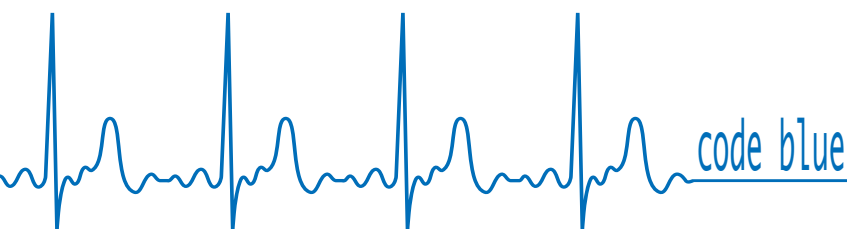

This would leave the physician responsible for collecting payment for a service already rendered, which can be very difficult.
